## 3) TENANT LANDLORD POLICY UPDATE

At the HRC Council Liaison meeting on January 12, 2017 (Attachment 1), Councilmembers Bosse and Reims made the following recommendations:

- 1) Have Community Development establish a database for the approximately 8600 Multifamily units (duplex and above).
- 2) Utilize database to establish a Rental Registry program in the City of Beverly Hills.
- 3) Change the current No-Cause Eviction ordinance in Beverly Hills to include a relocation fee.
- 4) Establish methods to limit annual 10% rent increases without improvements to unit.
