Greystone Concours d'Elegance Car Show on Hiatus

City Will Reevaluate Format and Timing of the Event

Beverly Hills, CA – The Concours d'Elegance car show at Greystone Mansion and Estate, held each May for the past eight years, has been put on hiatus while organizers reevaluate the event. The City of Beverly Hills will reconsider the timing and the format in order to enhance the benefit to residents and better complement other events held in the City.

The City will be meeting with stakeholders to discuss ways to ensure the long-term sustainability of the Concours event. Community services staff will work closely with the stakeholders to develop options to update the format and maximize the funds raised to support the restoration of Greystone.

The City sincerely thanks the Friends of Greystone and the sponsors, volunteers, exhibitors and vendors who have made the show a success for the past eight years.

Greystone Mansion and Estate, built in 1928, is a public park within the hillside area of Beverly Hills. The City of Beverly Hills purchased the property in 1965 and in 1971 established the 18.3-acre site as a public park, including the Greystone Mansion. In 1976, Greystone was listed in the National Register of Historic Places. In 2013 Greystone was designated Beverly Hills Local Historic Landmark No. 4.
